December 1, 2010

Fill your yellow recycling container with items listed below and place it curbside each week on your regular trash pickup day. No need to sort recyclables.

Paper Items:

- magazines
- corrugated cardboard
- telephone books
- catalogs
- mail – shredding personal documents recommended
- printer – copier paper
- cereal boxes – remove liner

Cans:

- aluminum
- tin or bi-metal cans
- containers and lids
- empty aerosol cans

Glass:

- green, brown and clear

Plastics:

Recycle codes 1 through 7, includes soft drink and water bottles, peanut butter and jam jars, squeezable bottles, milk containers and microwave ware.

Not Accepted:

- X** paint, anti-freeze and oil containers
- X** styrofoam
- X** plastic bags
- X** plastic toys
- X** batteries
- X** light bulbs
- X** wax cartons
- X** wire hangers

Residents may still drop off paper items at the various Abitibi recycling sites which contribute a portion of profits to charities.
